COUPON BOOKS: If you pay your lot rent by coupon, the new coupon books will be sent within the next couple of weeks. For those of you that pay by ACH, you do not need to do anything! **If you pay by Online banking, please make sure to go in and update the amount to reflect the change in your lot rent rate.**

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING: Garbage and Yard Waste collection changes:

* Wednesday, December, 25, 2024 (Christmas Day).. Trash, recycle and yard waste will be picked up Thursday, December 26, 2024).

* Wednesday, January 1, 2025 (New Year's Day). Trash, recycle and yard waste will be picked up Thursday, January 2, 2025 with your normal trash and yard waste.

Keep in mind, the county is experiencing a high volume of debris pick up and may be selective in picking up items, so please continue to be patient and place as many items as you can in your trash cans. They seem to pick those up much better than loose items. So, please place loose items in can if at all possible - especially small piles as they will not pick that up.

HOLIDAY COLLECTIONS: FYI: When a holiday falls on a scheduled pickup day, **garbage, recycling and yard waste will be collected one day later** than your scheduled pickup day for the rest of that week. Regular collection days resume the following Monday.

EMPTY HOMES: There are a few homes in the park that have been decimated and are empty. These homes are in the process of being evaluated by FEMA as well as the owner of Hawaiian Village and are not to be entered into for any reason. A few homes have had belongings taken that do not belong to them. Some have even taken plants that need to be returned as they belong to that particular lot. At some point in the future, should the home be determined to be removed and you would be interested in something on that home, you may contact me. There are NO TRESPASSING signs on the homes and you need to abide by that.
