<u>DELIVERIES</u>: If you receive something that does not belong to you, please either take it to the correct address or bring it to the office. Many people are missing packages and some people have been keeping them. Please be respectful and don't keep something that does not belong to you. The GPS takes drivers to the wrong street so let's help them out! Thank you for being neighborly and honest.

<u>LOT RENTS</u>: The new amounts go into effect January 1st, 2025. A letter was sent in September informing you of the amounts. The following choices are still in effect for making your payments: If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me.

- * <u>ACH (also known as direct debit)</u> Most have signed up for this option which is the most effective way. For this option, you do not need to do anything. The amount comes out on the 3rd of the month automatically. If you wish to switch to this method, please let me know.
- * <u>COUPON BOOK</u> The new books have been sent and you should have received it by now. (It should just be one coupon book.) They were sent to the address we had on record. The new coupon book has all the updated info in it including labels to the where they are to be mailed which is <u>Hawaiian Village</u>, <u>Newby Management</u>, <u>PO Box 20846</u>, <u>Tampa</u>, <u>Florida 33622-0846</u>. The labels are located in the back of the book.

- * <u>ONLINE BANKING</u>- If you currently use online banking whereby you enter the information yourself, <u>You Need To Update The Amount On Your Bank Website</u> or the amount paid will not be correct.
- * ONLINE PAYMENT PORTAL- The Resident Portal is at: www.newbymanagement.com. You can pay by e-check as well as by credit card. Should you choose to use your credit card, you will be charged the 3-5% processing fee that the credit card companies charge. You can also see your account with your charges and payments.

Some have indicated that their banks take the money out directly. This means that you have set it up directly with your bank to be taken out and you would need to contact your bank and update your NEW information with them. Again, your coupon book provides the new info.

<u>HOME REGISTRATIONS AND DECALS</u>: You may or may not have gotten something from the county via mail or email. However, please make sure that your decal has been renewed for 2025 if you have not already done so. Tax Collector Office Phone Number: (941) 741-4800. Renewal reminders are only sent as a courtesy per the county.

When is your decal renewal period? The registration period for mobile homes is January 1st through December 31st, with the **expiration date of December 31st**. It is the responsibility of the mobile home owner to renew their decal(s). When renewing, if you have a single-wide mobile home you will be issued one decal, and if you have a double- or triple-wide, you will receive two or three decals (i.e., one decal issued per side). These decals are affixed to one "master" backing decal, the color based on the year of expiration.

How do I display my decal(s)? Decals are to be displayed in the lower left-hand corner of the window closest to the street or road which provides access to the mobile home. Decals are to be visible at all times and are not to be covered by awnings, shutters, foliage, etc. (Discard all old decals.)

How do I renew my decal(s)? Online - Please visit taxcollector.com

Mail – Use your renewal notice stub. If you did not receive your renewal notice or have lost it, complete an **Application for Renewal**. If you have double or triple wide, complete a separate form for each registration.

In person – Visit taxcollector.com to schedule an appointment. Appointments are REQUIRED for all transactions. *** If the mobile home owner fails to renew their decal(s) they will receive a Notice of Impending Court Summons. Reminder – Renewal notices are mailed as a courtesy.
