<u>POOL CLOSURE</u>: Unfortunately, the pool has a severe leak and I have it scheduled this week to determine where the leak is so that I can schedule the repair based on their findings. I apologize for the inconvenience and I am trying to get this done as soon as possible.

<u>SCHOOL ZONES</u>: As many of you know schools are back in session and several people have received tickets. Some warnings were issued back in August and now if you are speeding within the school zone - even during the day (even when the lights are NOT flashing), you could be sited with a speeding violation. They have cameras that monitor your speed.

TREES: Several have inquired about trees and I want to provide you with what is in the Prospectus and in Chapter 723, the Florida Mobile Home Act.

<u>Prospectus - Page 7</u>: "The services provided by the Park as of the filing date include operation and maintenance of the clubhouses, shuffleboard courts and lawn cutting, as needed, of the common areas and lots. All other services are on a fee-paid basis and are the resident's sole responsibility."

Chapter 723 of the Florida Mobile Home Act, is clear with respect to the park owner's obligations to maintain the common areas of the park, and the home owner's obligations to maintain their individual lot (including trees). As such, it is the homeowner's responsibility to maintain the trees, shrubbery or other landscaping on the lot. Please ensure that your lots are properly maintained and contact me if you have any questions.

### 2 INGREDIENT PUMPKIN BREAD

1 Box of Spice Cake Mix

1 15 oz. can of pumpkin puree

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. In large bowl, combine the pumpkin puree and the spice cake mix. Be careful not to overmix. Spray a loaf pan with nonstick spray or line with parchment paper. Pour into the pan. Bake for 40-45 minutes until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Frost, if desired, with cream cheese frosting.


- Options: Can add some nuts, chocolate chips or raisins.


